### Philosophy

Pine Ridge Preschool is a ministry which instills Christian values and provides a quality early childhood educational experience. First and foremost, our goal is to provide an environment where the child feels loved and safe and one that nurtures the total child. Children will be encouraged to learn and grow by providing a foundation of developmentally appropriate experiences where each child can succeed.

### Curriculum

The curriculum emphasizes thematic units for each week and focuses on monthly "Fruits of the Spirit." These themes are presented using a variety of teaching methods to meet the learning styles of each child. Children learn through literature and art based activities, creative and dramatic play, and hands-on experiences, allowing individual growth and development of a positive self-image.

#### **Pre-Kindergarten**

(Must be potty trained & 4 years old before Aug. 1st):

M/W/Th from 9:00 - 11:45 A.M.

Tu/W/F from 9:00 - 11:45 A.M.

#### **3 & 4 Year-Olds**

(Must be potty trained & 3 years old before Aug. 1st):

M/Th from 9:00-11:45 A.M.

Tu/F from 9:00-11:45 A.M.

### Holidays

### Tuition

Tuition is to be paid on the 1st of each month. Tuition paid after the 10th of the month will have a \$10.00 late fee charged. Payments may be given to the director, teacher, or mailed to the church. Checks should be made payable to: Pine Ridge Preschool.

### Fees

- 2 days/week = \$100/month
- 3 days/week = \$150/month
- Annual Registration fee = \$65/child or \$100/family

\*Preschool operates September through May. Each month is equal in payment, regardless of days in attendance.

### Cancellations

If a child is out due to illness, please call the preschool at 816-584-1655 opt. 2, and leave a message. **There will be no credit given due to missed days.**

### Illness

To protect against illness, children are not allowed at school if they have been vomiting, had diarrhea, or had a fever of 100 or higher in the last 24 hours. If a child becomes sick while at school, the parents will be notified immediately. Student files must have complete and updated emergency contact information.

### Immunizations

All children must be current on immunizations to attend Pine Ridge Preschool. **Our facility does not accept immunization exemptions.**

  - Read books by pictures
  - Retell stories – key points
  - Begin to recognize rhyming words
